

## JNIOR Series 4 – Non Standard Usernames and Passwords

Requires JNIOR Support Tool version 7.3 or Greater

The following information describes how to manage your JNIOR Series 4 when using non-standard JNIOR usernames and passwords. JNIOR Support Tool version 7.3 or greater is required and can be downloaded from the INTEG website on either of the following web pages.

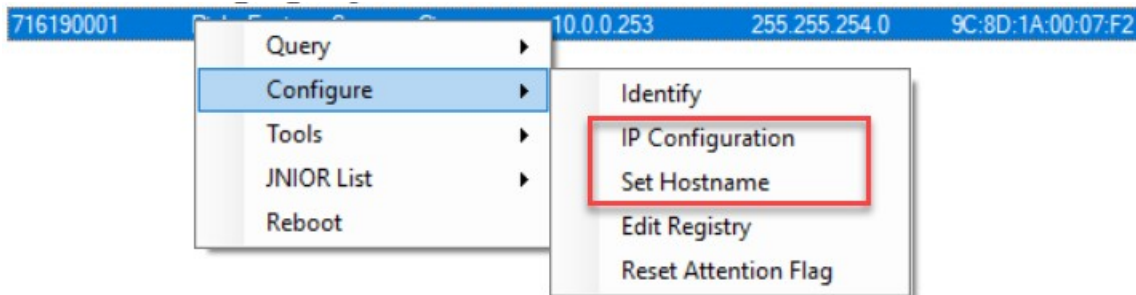

### BEACON Functionality

The JNIOR requires a username and password for many of the connections any device makes to the JNIOR. One exception was the Beacon protocol. The Beacon protocol is used in the JNIOR Support Tool when you are on the Beacon tab and ‘right-click’ on your JNIOR to configure the JNIOR IP settings or hostname.



With JNIOR Series 4 JANOS operating system version 1.6.3 or greater, the Beacon functionality must now login to the JNIOR when requesting to change the JNIOR IP settings or hostname. The default username/password combination of jnior/jnior is used in the background by JNIOR Support Tool version 7.3 or greater.

**NOTE: If you are using a non jnior/jnior username and password, then please see the Application Note on using non-standard passwords with the JNIOR Support Tool. JNIOR Support Tool version 7.3 or greater handles non-standard usernames and passwords for all the functions of the JNIOR Support Tool including Beacon.**
